Job Function:

Position requires a professional with strong interest in adults with developmental disabilities, including autism. The individual must be committed and able to build meaningful relationships with 3LPlace's program members and view each member through a holistic lens. The individual must possess the skills and insight to understand **each** 3LPlace member participant, in terms of their unique developmental, physical, sensory, emotional, social, and cognitive strengths and challenges. The individual must be energetic, demonstrate initiative, and project positive affect. 3LPlace utilizes a multi-disciplinary approach and the individual must be committed to working and sharing insights as a team member. Specific Duties:

- Develop a relationship with each member of the 3LPlace team. Work as a multidisciplinary team member.
- Develop competency working with each member's individual developmental profile, including their sensory, emotional, social, physical, and cognitive strengths and challenges.
- Understand the 3LPlace vision and framework as presented in Transition Curriculum, including emphasis on a multi-disciplinary framework.
- Work collaboratively and creatively with the Clinical Director to develop visually engaging materials, lesson plans, program tools to support learning goals of 3LPlace modules as well as individualized goals relevant to 3LPlace members.
- Coach and supervise direct service staff
- Acquire and supervise undergraduate and graduate level intern/s from related programs at local universities
- Provide professional development in areas that improve staff awareness of and action towards current developmental ethics and practices
- Co-create and run groups during and beyond the day programming context
- Help develop and implement reporting and assessment tools used by 3LPlace.
- Participates in program planning, staff meetings and staff development trainings
- Work with 3LPlace families to support social/emotional issues that impact 3LPlace members.
- Engage in community outreach to enhance social and employment opportunities for 3LPlace members in the community.
- Employ differentiated instruction that meets each member's social/emotional needs and learning styles at their developmental levels.
- Maintain professional competence and continuous improvement through in-service education and other professional growth activities.
- Participates in program planning, staff meetings and staff development trainings
- Performs other duties within the scope of his/her employment and certification as may be assigned.
